### First BCSP Scholarship Fund Awarded

Savoy, Illinois—April 14, 2008—The American Society of Safety Engineers Foundation (ASSEF) has announced its 2008 scholarship winners and Samuel C. Hafley has been awarded the Board of Certified Safety Professionals (BCSP) Glenn Daviet Scholarship. Mr. Hafley will receive a \$1,000 scholarship to use toward his undergraduate studies.

"I consider it a great honor to be chosen as the first to receive this award, and I appreciate BCSP's confidence in me and their willingness to invest in my educational goals," said Mr. Hafley, currently pursuing his Safety Management degree (with a minor in Fire Science) at the University of Central Missouri. He expects to graduate in 2010 and would like to work in energy production, chemical production, or hazardous material disposal.

The BCSP Scholarship Fund was created as a means for BCSP to contribute to the safety, health, and environmental profession. The first scholarship was named in honor of Glenn D. Daviet, CSP, CPCU, ARM, ALCM. At the time of his passing in July 2007, Mr. Daviet was serving as BCSP's Secretary-Treasurer. He had been a BCSP Director since 2004 and contributed significantly to safety professionalism through and with BCSP.
