DoD COOL Benefits:

The Department of Defense's Credentialing Opportunities On-Line (COOL) program also offers support for achieving professional certifications. Each military service's COOL program includes BCSP's ANSI-accredited certifications.

Army service members: Additional benefits are provided by the Army Credentialing Assistance Program which can provide funds for BCSP application fees, exam fees, examCORE pre-exam trainings, annual renewal fees, and BCSP recertPRO.

VA Benefits:

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) provides education benefits to eligible service members, veterans, and certain dependents and survivors. Applicants may receive financial support for undergraduate and graduate degrees, vocational and technical training, licensing and certification tests, apprenticeships, on-the-job training, and more. Some of these programs may pay for BCSP certification exam fees and other training applicable to your career in safety and health.
